CAMP BEREA

• New Kitchen Windows: The state of NH no longer allows porous materials, such as wood, in camp kitchens, so we were required to replace the kitchen windows with a safer, cleaner option. This provides better security, better airflow, more light, and more height and depth for coffee and tea, and allows for more interaction between our guests and kitchen staff! We are grateful for this increased opportunity to share God's love with our guests while we serve them. This might sound like a simple project, but it was actually quite detailed. 
- Summer Update: It has been a great summer so far! The energy is high, and our new Site

We haven't seen her Bible open in well over a year. Yesterday, when we picked her up from day camp, she had her Bible open on the car ride home and was reading intently! We are so excited to see her delving into Scripture and eagerly praying to see her put her faith in Christ!"

Camper Discipleship Program (CDP) Testimony:

"Berea has always been a safe space for me to come, reflect, and engage with people I trust. This past year, I was battling bad decisions I was making and unhealthy relationships I was developing. Guilt and shame were weighing me down. At camp this summer, I really felt God's presence for the first time. During worship, I finally broke down. That night, I opened up to people about things I never thought I would share. By the end of the week, I felt God calling me to join the CDP program, which was only 3 days away! I had plans after camp, but none of that mattered- my focus was here at Camp Berea. CDP was 100% the right decision. It allowed me to take deeper Next Steps in my faith and gave me the opportunity to serve and learn that "it's not about me". The leadership training was eye-opening! While shadowing a cabin, I got to help a girl take her Next Steps. I really felt God quiding my every word!"





"One of our campers was very nervous about coming to day camp as she had a bad experience at a different, local camp. Every day, she has been having more fun and learning more about Christ. For most of the week she has been picked up early, but by the end of the week, she was begging her parents to let her stay the whole time so she could be here for the final campfire rally and Bible story!"
